Ben Stelter captured hearts across the country and the NHL before he passed away in August. He was diagnosed with glioblastoma — an aggressive type of brain cancer – at the age of four. He underwent surgery to remove the tumour, as well as several rounds of chemotherapy and dozens of radiation sessions. He was six years old when he passed away.

His parents Mike and Lea helped create the Ben Stelter Memorial Fund that raises funds to fight cancer and provide experiences for children battling cancer.

All sales (proceeds) go to the Ben Stelter Foundation (a registered charity) and so your purchase is going to help children battling cancer, and their families.




Tag along with Cecily and Cosmo as they go on an incredible adventure, finding a magical coin, and unlocking the secret of what really matters.






New Clubs!!!




