STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students are expected to dress in clothing suitable for a K-12 school setting. Any form of dress which is considered contrary to good hygiene, is disruptive, distractive in appearance and/or detrimental to the purpose or conduct of our school will not be permitted.

Your appearance should not detract from the educational focus of our school. School administration reserves the right to make the final decision on the appropriateness of student dress.

Guidelines:

1. Dress should be clean and tidy.

2. Revealing clothing and bare feet are examples of dress not conducive to learning. You must wear shirts that cover your stomach, chest area, and pants pulled high enough to cover under garments. Suitable shoes or sandals must worn in school at all times.

3. Clothing with suggestive logos or inappropriate slogans is not permissible. This includes, but is not limited to, any clothing or accessories:

- advertising alcoholic beverages or drugs,
- logos/references to alcohol or drugs, and/or
- those with obscenities, sexual innuendo or questionable printing/pictures.

You will be sent home to change, asked to cover the offensive material, or wear gym strip to ensure appropriate dress is present in BGS.

4. Suitable gym strip and shoes are required for physical education. Blazers Gym Strip (t-shirts, shorts and sweatpants) will be sold.

It is understood that expectations within a K-12 environment cannot be absolute; therefore the acceptability of dress code will take into consideration age and appropriateness and will be at the discretion of BGS staff.
