RE: COVID-19 Case At Bowden Grandview School

We are writing to inform you that, since the time of our last letter, there have been three additional cases of COVID-19 in individuals who attend Bowden Grandview School. These individuals did not attend school while potentially infectious and consequently **no** students or staff at Bowden Grandview will be required to isolate.

Because the individuals followed the correct protocols and stayed home while awaiting test results and were away on Spring Break, our staff and students will continue their learning as per normal. Please note that our division will follow the <u>Freedom of Information and Protection of</u> <u>Privacy</u> where information regarding specific individuals will not be made public.

We are grateful for these individuals informing us, as the information assists us in taking swift measures to protect the health and safety of the entire school community and to mitigate the spread of the virus. If your child receives a positive test result during the school day, please contact your school. If it is after school hours, please use this link to inform us through a <u>confidential form</u>. Thank you.

We remind parents/guardians of students to monitor for any signs of symptoms of COVID-19. Please remember to complete the <u>Alberta Health Daily Checklist</u> each day prior to attending school. If you or your child have any of the symptoms of illness listed on the daily checklist, you should stay home and use the <u>COVID-19 self assessment tool</u> or call Health Link at 811.
