Bubble bubble POP! The Kinders celebrated 4 days left of Kindergarten with a bubble day! The giant bubbles were a hit- and so fun to POP!




Literacy Corner



The Family Book is a children's book written by Todd Parr that details the daily lives of all kinds of families.




Love Makes a Family by Sophie Beer




Indigenous Education

A resource has been in the works of online books designed for early Cree readers. The books are currently only available in the Plains Cree dialect, but creators of this resource hope to offer them in a variety of other dialects as soon as they can.

Indigenous Storybooks is a resource designed specifically for children, families, community members, and educators. Inspired by the open-licensed stories from Little Cree Books, this project aims to make the text, images, and audio of stories available in Indigenous languages as well as English, French, and the most widely spoken immigrant and refugee languages of Canada.



