Across Canada the results are as follows:

More than 900,000 votes were reported from 5,900 schools, with results from all 343 electoral districts.

Students elected a Conservative minority government and the Liberal Party formed the official opposition.

- Conservative Party: 165 seats, 36.4% of the vote
- Liberal Party: 145 seats, 31.7% of the vote
- Bloc Québécois: 18 seats, 2.1% of the vote
- NDP: 13 seats, 14.5% of the vote
- Green Party: 2 seats, 7.5% of the vote






