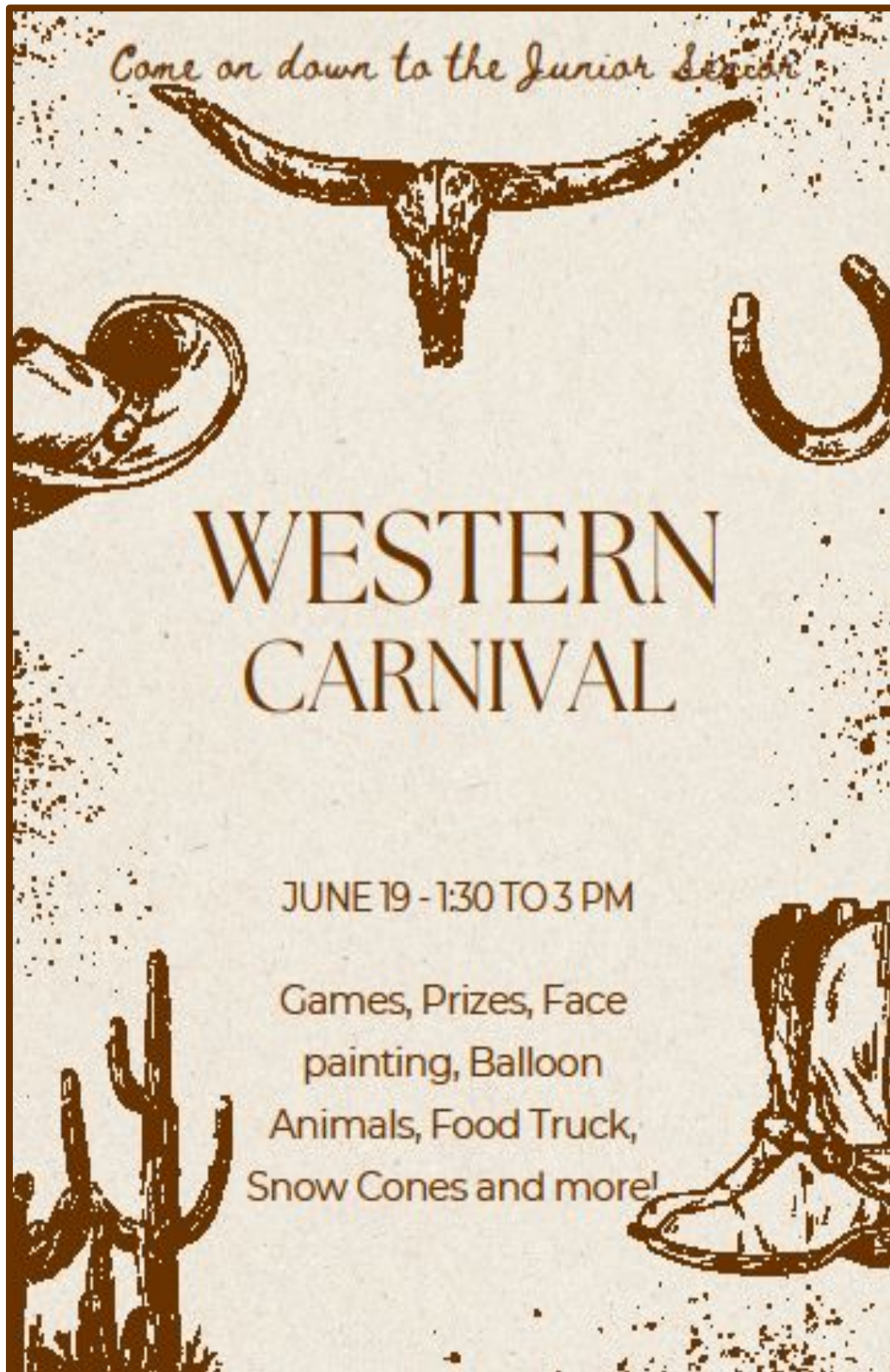

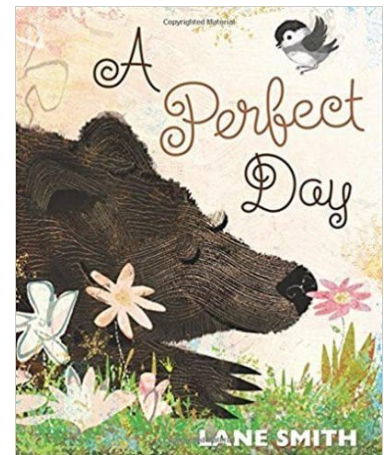
Literacy Corner

And just like that, the first day of summer sneaks up on us this week. Here are a few sweet picks for summer vacation reading:



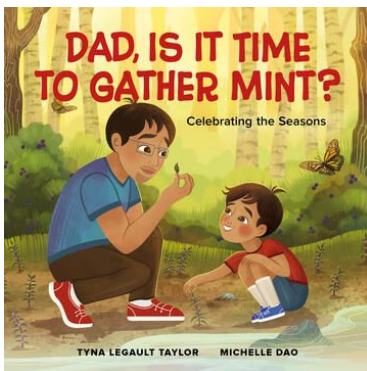
Wild Summer: Life in the Heat by Sean Taylor and Alex Morss

Joshua loves being on the land. When the weather is warm, Joshua and his dad gather mint from the shores of Animbiigoo Zaagi'igan Anishinaabek (Lake Nipigon First Nation) in northeastern Ontario.
