

We are recruiting high school students from Central Alberta to take part in a <u>free</u> training program to teach about life in the fire service. Cadet program attendees will receive theory, hands-on training, as well as an opportunity to graduate with NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 certification (issued by ProBoard and IFSAC) and join the ranks of Red Deer County Protective Services.


