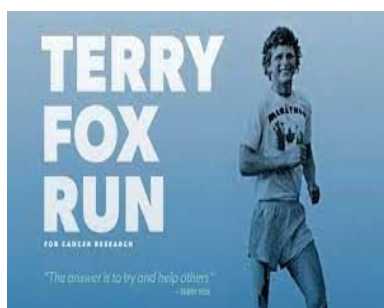



This is my 3rd year with BGS and I love the work I do! If I'm not at work, I am doing my own school assignments, having a coffee or baking sourdough!

CADET TRAINING PROGRAM

RED DEER COUNTY FIRE SERVICES IS LAUNCHING OUR FIRE CADET PROGRAM!

We are recruiting high school students from Central Alberta to take part in a free training program to teach about life in the fire service. Cadet program attendees will receive theory, hands-on training, as well as an opportunity to graduate with NFPA 1001 Firefighter Level 1 certification (issued by ProBoard and IFSAC) and join the ranks of Red Deer County Protective Services.



TIME & LOCATION

- Program is a one-year commitment (September to June) with expected attendance of 1 weeknight and occasional Saturdays.
- Classes will be held both at your local fire hall as well as at Station 6 (located at 249 Clearview Drive)

- Only those selected for an interview will be contacted.



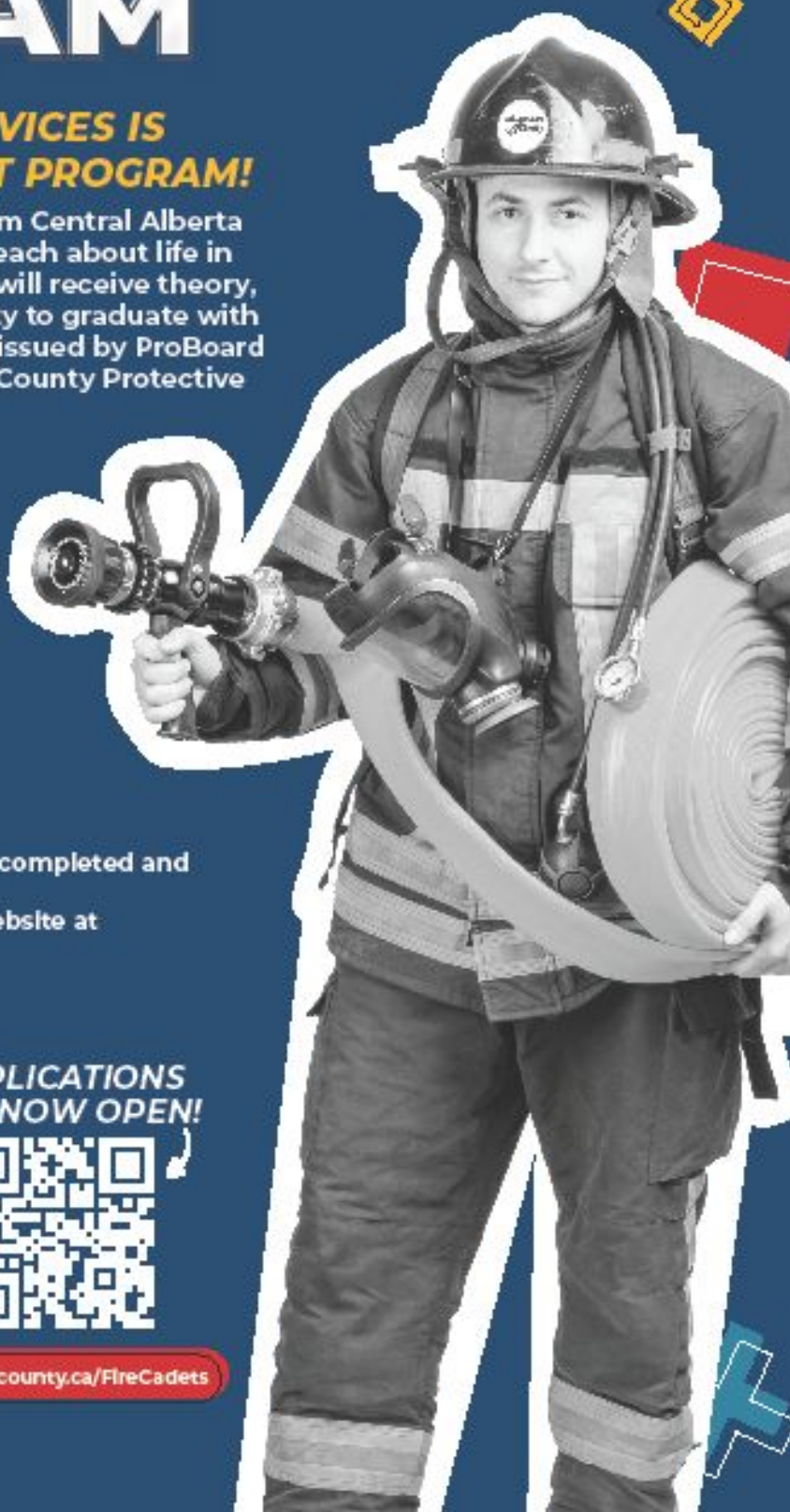

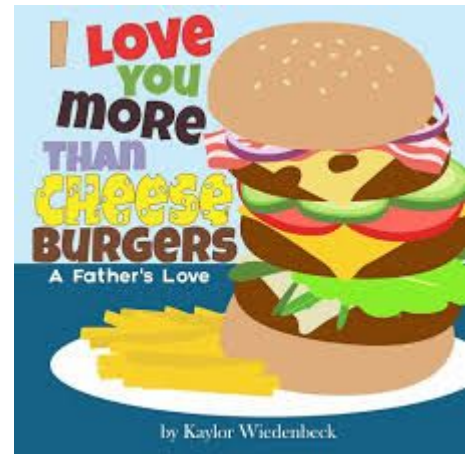

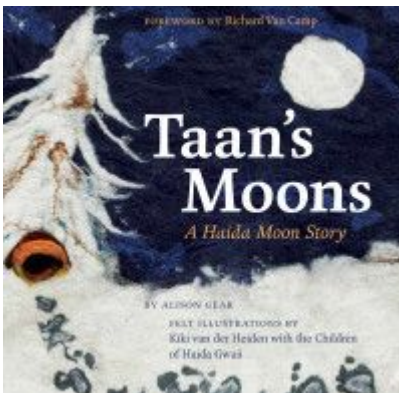
I Love You More Than Cheeseburgers: A Father's Love
